# Cocktails

## CLASSICS

### Cosmopolitan £8

Did it originate in trendy San Francisco bars in the 1970s, or during the 30s as others claim? Whenever it was born, one thing is certain, the refreshing mix of cranberry and fresh lime shaken with vodka and orange liqueur is one to try again and again

### Tom Collins £8

First thought to have been served in 1876 in a London hotel, this cocktail soon became popular worldwide. Called 'decadent homemade lemonade', the blend of fresh lemon and gin makes it the perfect accompaniment to a hot summer's day

### Margarita £8

Early stories date this cocktail to the 1930s in Mexico. Today it's the most popular tequila-based cocktail in the world. With the combination of tequila, orange liqueur, fresh lime and a salt rimmed glass, it's not for the faint-hearted

### Old Fashioned £8

Originally referred to as the 'bittered sling' in May 1806, the Old Fashioned captures the simplicity of making cocktails with great taste. Using rye whiskey, angostura bitters and sugar, the combination is sweet, but still packs a punch

### Bloody Mary £8

The name Bloody Mary is associated with Queen Mary I. Enjoyed globally, bartenders often adds their own twist on this traditional vodka and tomato juice concoction

### Mojito £8

A traditional mojito contains five ingredients: white rum, sugar, fresh lime juice, sparkling water and mint. The combination of sweet, citrus and mint was developed to complement the kick of rum and today it's one of the world's most recognised cocktails

### Daiquiri £8

Invented during the Spanish-American war, this cocktail was named after Daiquiri beach in Santiago, Cuba. Traditionally made in a shaker with rum, fresh lime and sugar, there are many adaptations – we add fresh strawberries blended to a smooth finish

## MARTINI

A very dry cocktail, traditionally made with gin or vodka, vermouth is then added as per the drinker's individual taste, and the finished result is a smooth, chilled cocktail with a touch of class

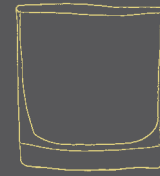


## THE GIN EXPERIENCE

Gin is one of the most popular spirits worldwide, with many styles and flavours. Since its invention in the 17th century, gin quickly became popular in England when it became legal to produce it unlicensed. This period was soon nicknamed the 'Gin Craze', and most gins were flavoured with turpentine to keep production costs cheaper. Thankfully by the 19th century, new techniques had been introduced and what followed was the production of gin with softer and sweeter styles. Today most gins revolve around the juniper berry as the main botanical, and with quality gin becoming increasingly popular, we believe we've perfected the gin experience

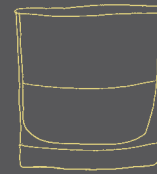

## MALT WHISKY

Glenmorangie 10 Year Malt £4.20

Bowmore 12 Year Malt £4.20

A beautiful balance of lemon, honey and peaty smokiness. Proclaimed by the late great whisky writer, Michael Jackson, as 'remarkably long and complex'

Cragganmore 12 Year Malt £4.70

Awarded two double gold, one gold and three silver medals between 2005 and 2012. Cragganmore 12 Year has proved itself worldwide for its unique taste and aroma

Macallan's Gold £4.70

Glenkinchie 12 Year Malt £4.70

This 12 year old malt is a replacement for the original 10 year old Glenkinchie. With new notes of lemon and cut grass, you'll appreciate its fresh and light character

Dalwhinnie 15 Year Malt £5.20

Being the highest distillery in Scotland, Dalwhinnie takes advantage of the clean spring waters. The smoky, floral aroma is a perfect balance for beginners in the malt experience

Oban 14 Year Malt £5.20

Produced in one of the smallest distilleries in Scotland, Oban boasts a West Highland flavour, combining sweet and smoky notes on the palate

Ardbeg 10 Year Malt £5.20

Voted Whisky of the Year in 2008, some call it a must-have for fans of single malt. Boasting a combination of flavours of lemon, lime, vanilla and smokiness, this is a masterpiece

Laphroaig 10 Year Malt £5.20

A full-bodied malt distilled in the same way today as 75 years ago. The smoky flavour is made from peat only found on Islay, giving Laphroaig its unique rich flavour

Lagavulin 16 Year Malt £5.20

The peaty malt flavour originates from its maturing in bourbon and sherry casks. The distinctive taste is recognised and appreciated worldwide

Haig Blue Single Grain Scotch £5.20
